

## **Payphone Compensation Notice**

Remitting Carrier: NTS Communications, Inc. (NTS)  
Remittance Period: Third Quarter 2013

Dear Payphone Service Provider:

Your payphone compensation is enclosed. This compensation is sent to you pursuant to your notification to NTS of your status as a payphone service provider (PSP), and is based upon your claim of ownership of those payphones for which you have requested compensation for the period indicated above.

You will find enclosed a summary report of your compensable calls and related compensation. Please note that this is a summary of your remittance information. The enclosed disk contains all the required detailed information pertaining to your remittance. The data on the disk can be converted to an Excel file or an Access database.

Please note the following with respect to the calculation of your remittance:

This compensation is for completed calls only. Completed calls are determined based upon carefully developed standards for answer conditions.

This compensation does not include any calls for which the payphone identifier number was not transmitted in the call record or which NTS is not otherwise able to track. Calls not included for these reasons are believed to be de minimus.

This compensation may not include certain calls for which the originating payphone was concurrently claimed by another PSP, or by an aggregator. Where payphone ownership was claimed by more than one PSP, NTS applied its best efforts to resolve the conflicting claims. Where calls were claimed by both an aggregator and an individual PSP, the remittance was sent to the aggregator.
